- ✓ fruit and vegetable waste
- ✓ eggshells
- ✓ coffee grounds, filters, tea, tea bags
- ✓ leftover food, even cooked
- ✓ old food (without packaging!)
- ✓ flowers, plants (without pot!)
- ✓ garden waste
- ✓ leaves
- ✓ wrapping paper, e.g. newspaper or kitchen paper

Not that one

- ✗ compostable plastic bags
- ✗ small animal litter, cat litter, dog excrement
- ✗ wood, sand, stones

glass containers

- ✓ glass bottles
- ✓ glasses
- ✗ window panes
- ✗ light bulbs



This belongs in the green bin

- ✓ yoghurt and margarine cups
- ✓ beverage cartons
- ✓ cans
- ✓ vacuum packaging, e.g. for sausage or cheese
- ✓ plastic cosmetic bottles, tubes, spray cans
- ✓ packaging Styrofoam

Not that one

- ✗ plastic Tableware
- ✗ plastic pipes
- ✗ clothes hanger

Collection of bulky waste
(twice a year upon request)

- ✓ furniture, mattresses
- ✗ renovation waste
- ✗ sanitary ware (toilet bowl, sink)

Collection of electronic waste
(twice a year upon request)

- ✓ electrical appliances such as television, refrigerator, washing machine



This belongs in the blue bin

- ✓ newspapers, magazines
- ✓ catalogs, brochures
- ✓ books, paper notebooks
- ✓ cardboard, boxes
- ✓ wrapping paper
- ✓ pizza boxes (only if they are clean and uncoated!)
- ✓ cardboard egg cartons

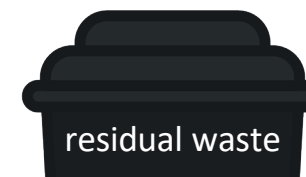
Not that one

- ✗ dirty or coated paper
- ✗ beverage cartons
- ✗ photos

Pollutant collection

(twice a year, dates announced in the waste calendar)

- ✓ batteries
- ✓ energy saving lamps
- ✓ liquid paints and varnishes
- ✓ plant protection products



This belongs in the black bin

- ✓ cigarette butts
- ✓ ash, garbage
- ✓ vacuum cleaner bags
- ✓ ceramics, porcelain, clay
- ✓ Cleaning rags, sponges
- ✓ disposable diapers, cotton pads and swabs
- ✓ hygiene items, toothbrushes
- ✓ small animal litter, cat litter
- ✓ medications
- ✓ wallpaper remnants
- ✓ cured paints and varnishes
- ✓ rubber, leather, textiles
- ✓ glass and mirror shards

- ✗ pollutants
- ✗ batteries, electrical appliances
- ✗ construction rubble
